PASTORAL NOTES **A NEW SCHOOL TERM**
We often have appeals from missionary sisters or brothers. The Sisters of St Peter Claver who made the recent Appeal were very grateful for everyone's contribution. Missionaries have regularly been involved in having schools established as has happened in Europe over the centuries. Our own Sisters of Our Lady look back to a foundation in Germany, and the inspiration of St Julie from France. On 7th April, last Thursday, was the feast of St John-Baptist de la Salle, a French priest who founded an Order of teaching brothers. One school was established in Ipswich, Suffolk for many years, in London, and elsewhere. As we begin the summer term for our own schools in Kettering, we might remember all staff and pupils in our prayers, with gratitude for the dedicated work of many years in our parish.

UPDATED INFORMATION REGARDING St. EDWARD'S HALL KITCHEN.
Work on our kitchen refurbishment is now underway and should be completed by April 28th. All bookings in this period that do not require access to the kitchen will be honoured. Access to the hall will from now on be via the Ramp door as the kitchen must remain a sanitised area, maintained in accordance with latest health and safety regulations and inspected by the local council. Key holders should contact Nigel on 01536 460909 for a key to this door and to return the kitchen door key, except for users of the Upper Room who will continue to use the usual door and will retain that key. Upper Room users will not be able to pass through the kitchen to access the hall toilets but may use the outside toilet behind the Presbytery. There is now a kettle in the Upper Room kitchenette for making drinks.
The kitchen is for the preparation of food and drinks, only. As the filtered boiling water dispenser will be permanently on, children should not be there.
