PASTORAL NOTES

Cardinal Cormac Murphy-O'Connor

Our prayers are requested for the repose of the soul of Cardinal Cormac Murphy-O'Connor, former archbishop of Westminster, who died on 1st September just past. He was one of three brothers priests, of a family with some connection with our diocese through the parish of St Ethelbert's, Slough. They all studied in the English College in Rome, affectionately known to the Rugby fraternity – English and Italian – as the three big beasts! He was secretary to the Bishop of Portsmouth during the Vatican Council, before himself being made bishop and later archbishop. His humility and down-to-earth approach to all helped him through very difficult and challenging times. His funeral is at Westminster Cathedral on Tuesday 12th September. May he rest in peace.

Following Fr Pius's departure earlier that week, Father Paul Gonsalves will be arriving in Kettering for the weekend of 23rd and 24th September; he has written saying "Looking forward to serving God's people at St Edward's" and he has sent us a few brief biographical notes

Fr Paul Camilo Dominic Gonsalves of the order of Missionaries of St Francis De Sales (MSFS). He was ordained on 11th April 1999 and served as Rector of the Minor Seminary of the MSFS for 10 years in Orissa, an interior northern mission of India and doubled up as Parish Priest of St Francis de Sales Parish for 5 years in the same area. From September 2009 to April 2017 he served as Parish Priest of Our Lady of Mercy Parish, Katembe in the missions of Mozambique, Africa. He arrived in the UK on the 1st of May 2017 and has been supplying at St Teresa Beaconsfield, St Dunstan's Bourn End and St Augustine's High Wycombe since the 6th of May 2017.
