Many of the envelopes currently being used are not supported by such a declaration. **If you are a UK taxpayer**, who has not done so, please consider making a declaration. You can check the list circulated with this bulletin (**it really is this week, apologies for last week's printing problems!**) to see if a declaration is already in place; at the bottom of the list it tells you what to do if no declaration has been made. **At present over £15000 a year goes into envelopes without being Gift Aided, if it were all gift aided HM Revenue and Customs tax refund would bring that up to £20000.**
