## PASTORAL NOTES

Visitors to Rome inevitably go to St Peter's Basilica, with its famous dome designed by Michelangelo, and amazing piazza. If you can find the right spot to stand, you will see the rows of pillars in the surrounding arcade blend into one - it is so exact. The excavations underneath the basilica are also popular, recalling the ancient Roman amphitheatre where St Peter was martyred. The Egyptian obelisk in the piazza once stood there. St Paul's basilica survived from about 320 to 1820AD, when it was destroyed by fire. It was rebuilt as it had been (St Peter's is a 16th century edifice), so we can still see what an ancient Roman basilica looked like.
