## ALL SAINTS / ALL SOULS

Our modern Church Calendar makes special Holydays move to the Sunday, when they fall on a Saturday or Monday as well. So this year **ALL SAINTS** (usually 1st November) will be our Sunday celebration next weekend. (Since Sundays are held to begin on the Saturday evening for purposes of worship, **ALL SAINTS** begins then). **ALL SOULS**, a day of prayer for all the faithful departed, takes place on Monday. In some parishes people like to place names of their departed family/friends in an envelope, and these are left then by the altar throughout November. These envelopes can be put in the collection bag or handed in to the priest directly.

## TOO MANY SECOND COLLECTIONS?

Most second collections are Mandatory, we are required to take them by the Diocese, or the Bishops Council for England and Wales. In addition we do occasionally have special one off appeals, e.g. the recent one by Fr Richard on behalf of the Dominicans and of course this parish is famous for its generosity to victims of natural disasters. There are 11 Mandatory Collections during the year and four of them take place between 5th October and 16th November! there is one next week for the Bishop's maintenance, and a final one two weeks after for the sick and retired clergy fund.
