The one next Sunday is for our Bishop's Maintenance Fund, AND there is one the following week for The Sick and Retired Clergy Fund. Then there is a break until the Lent Cafod Collection on Sunday 12th March 2017. Across a year there are twelve Mandatory Collections, but they are not spread evenly.

The conclusion of the Year of Mercy is Sunday 20th November, The Feast of Christ The King. To mark the occasion in this Parish there will be "An Evening of Light", a longer than usual Benediction Service on **Thursday 10th November** 6.30pm to 8.30 pm. That will include an invitation to light a candle to the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, a quiet time with gentle music, for all the family. There will be an opportunity for individual prayer. Diocesan trained listening and prayer counsellors will be available if required. Tea and coffee in the hall afterwards.
