PASTORAL NOTES-

CHANGING PICTURES

On the sanctuary by the Reading-Stand there is a low table usually adorned with flowers and a variety of pictures. This Sunday is the feast of the Body & Blood of Christ, the Blessed Sacrament. The picture may not at first sight seem to fit the Mass, but a picture of Martyrs (Ugandan) is specially appropriate for the Mass, as showing Christians now offering themselves after the example of the Master. This Monday (3rd June) is the feast of the Uganda martyrs, twenty-two of them, some quite young boys, who refused to bow to the demands of the king in the turbulent times of the 19th century (1886). Anglican martyrs shared their example. There will be special celebrations in Father Jo's Refugee Settlement this Monday. Every consecrated altar in church has a relic sealed in it, a practice from the time of the early Christian martyrs. The relic is of a martyr and the priest reverences the altar where the relic is sealed.
