PASTORAL NOTES ELECTING A NEW POPE

The cardinals are gathering to elect a new Bishop of Rome. In the early centuries bishops were elected by the local Church, priests and people, the congregation pointing out often the one they believed appropriate. Pope Gregory (AD 597) was chosen in that way. He had shown his worth as a civil governor of Rome, a monk, and a deaconambassador for the Pope. The cardinals were originally the parish priests of Rome. Today they are both senior officials in the Vatican and also mostly national leading bishops. In the early centuries Rome was seen as a place to appeal to in doctrinal disputes, arguments over matters of faith. Otherwise, local communities and bishops had to live their mission in the normal way of prayer and charity. Now that communication is so swift around the world, do we need to recover our sense of being the Church also in our own place, with the gifts of the Holy Spirit there to enable us to live our witness to Christ responsibly – in our own circumstances and with our own challenges?
