PARISH ACCOUNTS: With this bulletin is one two sided sheet showing the Income and expenditure of this Parish during the financial year to 31st March 2013, together with a report by the Chairman of the Finance Committee. If you are not able to increase your giving at this time you might be able to help by ensuring that what you give is "Gift Aided". If you are paying sufficient UK tax you simply sign a gift aid form just once and then any amounts you put in a weekly envelope are counted up year by year and a tax refund of 25% increases the gift by 25%!

St Edward's Hall: All of the Electric Heaters have been overhauled or replaced and the gas heaters have had their annual service. Also any necessary replacements of florescent lighting tubes have been made.

Next Year, St Luke's Deanery Pilgrimage: Canon John will be leading a Pastoral Area pilgrimage to Rome, Assisi, Loreto and San Giovanni, 28 September – 6 October 2014, arranged through Pax Travel.
