PASTORAL NOTES **FERIA ?**
In the 'Readings for the Week' section of the Parish Newsletter, the feasts of Saints or of Our Lord are noted, but often the word 'Feria' appears. My Latin dictionary suggests to me that the word originally indicated 'holidays', or taking time off! In our calendar it has come to mean almost the opposite: No special feast or Saint's Day! Perhaps, then, a rest from feasts! As students for the priesthood in Rome, we helped out in Summer in a village in the mountains south of Rome, in a sort of 'Catechism Camp', games and instruction combined in a holiday atmosphere, using the local ancient Castle-grounds. People had to fetch water from a pump every day, as the only way to have enough – not much time off for them! In other circumstances people might find too much time on their hands. No work! We need both – 'Ferias' and 'Feasts', rest and our tasks – for ourselves and for our society.
