### Fr Paul and Sophie's Sponsored Canoe Trip For Lourdes Pilgrimage of Sick and Disabled

Sophie and I have completed just over 40 miles down the winding River Wye in a Canadian Canoe. We started several miles upstream of Hay on Wye in Wales at a campsite on the river bank behind the HollyBush Inn. After a night in an old Teepee tent, we set off and within an hour were tipped in to the river after failing to see a large rock just under the surface. Luckily it was a sunny day. It took us another day to get down to Hereford through beautiful quiet rural scenery. The final morning we rowed down from just south of Ross on Wye, finishing at Ye Olde Ferrie Inne, Simmonds Yat. The route is much shorter and straighter by road but less beautiful and fun.

### WORLD YOUTH DAY

Via priests or parishioners, our parish has been represented at a number of recent World Youth Days. The current event is to be celebrated very shortly in Brazil, 23-28<sup>th</sup> July. When hundreds of thousands of young Catholics gather with Pope Francis in Rio de Janeiro reflections on safeguarding the environment will be part of the programme. "When planning we thought that a major theme in Brazil, known as 'the lungs of the world', would have to be the environment" said the president of the John Paul II Foundation for Youth, which helps plan World Youth Day. The present demonstrations in Brazil also focus minds on the practical realities of people's lives in a world in which there is such abundance next to so much poverty.
