PASTORAL NOTES	ELECTING A BISHOP ?
This Sunday is the anniversary of the death of a former bishop, Arthur Riddell. He was bishop of Northampton from 1880-1907, so he was the bishop who erected our diocese. Like most of the bishops of our time, he was not chosen from this diocese. Born in September 1836 in Paris, he was ordained priest in 1858 and became a curate in Hull, then parish priest at Scarborough, before coming to us. He is now buried outside Northampton Cathedral. The bishops of our country have to agree on three names for possible bishops, and then send them to the Papal Nuncio (ambassador) who lives at Wimbledon in London. He adds his own comments and sends the names on to a committee/'Congregation' for the selection of bishops in Rome. (The Canons of the diocese may propose a name to the bishops!) It is a rather cumbersome arrangement. In England alone there are now eight dioceses without a bishop – one for three years. Local bishops and congregations were able to sort these things in the early centuries. Excessive bureaucracy can afflict the Church too!
