### PASTORAL NOTES

#### SS CYRIL & METHODIUS EUROPEAN SAINTS ?

We are very conscious, economically and otherwise, of belonging to Europe. The efforts to bring peace after World War II, following so many centuries of warfare, have surely borne some fruit. Saint Benedict, great Abbot of Monte Casino in Italy in the 6<sup>th</sup> century, is a special figure of prayer, monastic life and fraternal unity. Saint Bridget of Sweden is another patron from the 14<sup>th</sup> century: her religious order, boasting one English Martyr, continues to this day in Rome. Saints Cyril & Methodius, Greek missionaries in Eastern Europe among the Slavic peoples, are remembered this Thursday. They all witness to Christ's Peace, to make us peacemakers among the family of nations also.
