PASTORAL NOTES

MOTHERING SUNDAY

There was a time, a few centuries ago, when 25th March, the feast of the Annunciation, was also New Year's Day. So, January, February ... would be 2012, but on 25th March become 2013! This year, the feast of the Annunciation happens to fall in Holy Week, so is postponed quite a long time, to 8th April. (St Joseph keeps his feast, on 19th March). As we celebrate mothering Sunday and pray for all mothers, we are also reminded of the Mother of the Lord who faithfully stood by the Cross of her Son, where she also was given as mother to the beloved disciple, and so to all the Church. A hymn to Our Lady for this Sunday (4th of Lent) seems also appropriate. The oldest Christian paintings known to us, in the Roman, underground, burial chapels, include the Last Supper, the Church shown as a ship in the storm, and Our Lady, the One who prays.
