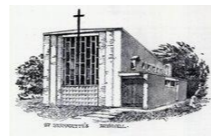

PASTORAL NOTES

Many of us are used to moving house frequently over a life-time, often for reasons of work. Priests move to many different parishes over a life-time. Now our priests face an unusual and temporary move still **within** our parish. The Bishop wishes the presbytery to be repaired and refurbished and to make this possible we have to rent an unfurnished house nearby, within the next few weeks. Details will be provided as soon as they are definite: telephone numbers, e-mails will remain the same. Normal services will be maintained. At the Easter Vigil the Deacon entered the dark church with the single light of the great Paschal Candle, and we all followed and received light from it. That Candle remains on the sanctuary to Pentecost inclusive. The one light of Christ, the light of faith, guides us all in the Church today and through the ages, but in constantly changing circumstances and also with many good companions.
