**PASTORAL NOTES** **5<sup>th</sup> November !**  
The story of Guy Fawkes is known quite well-known, a group of Catholics trying to blow up the Houses of Parliament and the King in 1605. When Queen Elizabeth died in 1603, Catholics hoped the new king, James I, would be less taxing as his mother had been a Catholic (Mary Queen of Scots, beheaded in 1587). In fact, the taxes on Catholics for non-attendance at church were increased. Our part of the county of Northamptonshire has many sites connected with these events – Rushton Hall with the Triangular Lodge and Fotheringhay, north of Oundle, among them. Less well-known are efforts over the subsequent centuries to bring divided Christians together again. This has borne fruit tremendously in our own time, often in very practical social ways, as with the Street Pastors, but in countless other charitable efforts where people of different denominations work together. Unity is one of the marks of the Church and we should continue to pray for an ever deeper closeness.
