PASTORAL NOTES

OUR LADY'S ASSUMPTION

In the Holy Year of 1950 Pope Pius XII celebrated a special proclamation of the Church's faith in the Assumption of Our Lady into heaven, sharing in the resurrection of her Son. Early paintings of Our Lady's 'falling asleep' or dormition, show her being cradled in the arms of Jesus in glory. We sometimes speak of roles being reversed in old age, where the children look after elderly parents. In the painting there is perhaps a suggestion of coming to full birth. The eastern tradition of our faith speaks, in death, of our coming to God not so much as a final purification (Purgatory) but as a final coming to full maturity in God – an encouragement to us who are nurtured each day, our growing – as St Paul says – in Christ.
