## PASTORAL NOTES

A word from Father Jo Kizito on this Mission Sunday: "The rain season started last week after four to five months of a dry spell. It means that our refugees and the nationals around our settlement are extremely busy in the field in preparation for the planting season. Likewise, with part of the donation from our good Samaritans of St Edward's, we procured some small scale farming tools for our new huge refugees' arrivals. Now 5,699 homesteads are to profit from this charity. So we are busy with them helping to catch up with the planting season and to make sure that the tools reach down to the grass-roots beneficiaries. Of course, a small portion of the fund has to be spared for Isaac's end of the year academic term in the seminary. 'Kill many birds with one stone', a wise saying!" (Uganda, 7<sup>th</sup> September 2009) and another word: 'I am Isaac, a son of a refugee family from Congo whom Father Kizito introduced to you last Christmas. I now write to thank you Canon John and your kind community of St Edward's parish for accepting to support my studies in the seminary'".
