PASTORAL NOTES

LET THE CHILDREN COME TO ME

The children among us are a source of great joy and encouragement in the life of the Church. We desire Jesus words, "Let the children come to me" to echo in all our hearts. It is with this in mind and recognising the enormous challenges of parenthood that the following is mentioned:

Sound carries from the narthex at the back of the church through into the main body of the church far more than you might think. Often children are no more noisy than some adults, bit it is gently suggested that if a child is really shouting or crying very loudly for a sustained period could they be taken outside for a short while? Regular attendance at the children's liturgy during the 10.30am Sunday Mass is also a good way of helping children of an appropriate age learn what it is to be part of the Church, though of course this is not always practical for many parents. In the end it is the example of us adults that will inspire in children a loving reverence for the Mass before which we all come as Children of God.
