**PASTORAL NOTES** **FIRST HOLY COMMUNION**  
At this time of year we enjoy the celebrations of First Holy Communion with our schools and many others from local schools. It was on 8<sup>th</sup> August 1910 that Pope St Pius X gave permission for children to receive Holy Communion at the 'age of reason', namely the age of seven, along with the Sacrament of Reconciliation. For us it resulted in the order of the Sacraments being somewhat altered, as Confirmation always preceded Holy Communion, though now commonly at the end of Junior School, around the age of 11. Great care is taken in the preparation for these sacraments and we have to thank teachers and catechists. As a footnote, we might remember St Bernadette who, through illness and being behind in her lessons, had yet to make her First Holy Communion when Our Lady appeared to her. But Bernadette was able to pray her Rosary, a gift commonly given to First Communion candidates and a permanent help to prayer.
