PASTORAL NOTES

POPES & OUR PARISH

When the first Mass was said in a pub in Market Square, Kettering in 1891, the reigning Pope was Leo XIII (1878-1903), remembered for speaking out for justice for working people. By the time (1940) St Edward's present church was built, the pope was Pius XII (1939-1958), controversial over his apparent silence about the Holocaust, but certainly saving many Jewish people in the Vatican and church institutions throughout Italy by his quiet direction. By the time our Rothwell church was blessed (1959) it was Pope John XXIII (1958-1963) who called Vatican Council II, calling the Church to renewal in our present age. Pope Paul VI (1963-1978) was pope when Desborough and Burton Latimer churches were opened (1972), Pope John Paul II (1978-2005) was of course seen by many in a first ever papal visit to Britain (1982) in Coventry, London and elsewhere, and Pope Benedict XVI has been to see us also in 2010, beatifying Cardinal John Henry Newman. We continue now to hold Pope Francis and Bishop Peter in our prayers at every Mass.

St Jude's Local Foodbank, Kettering.

The Foodbank is a registered Charity No. 1054425 and is part of East Northants Community Services. It is part of a national chain of foodbanks, which has fed 100,000 people throughout the UK in the last six months of 2012.

It is an ecumenical Christian based ministry serving people of all faiths and none. The main focus is on those who are in crisis, homeless or addicted. People access the Foodbank directly or through a voucher system and referrals from a variety of Caring Agencies.
