PASTORAL NOTES

S. AMERICAN CONNECTION

With a Pope from Argentina who recently met the national teams of Italy and Argentina before a pre-season 'friendly' tournament, it seems right to remember the first canonised saint of South America, St Rose of Lima in Peru, whose feast falls on Friday. She rather represents the prayerful, contemplative side of our faith, being a (lay) member of the Third Order of St Dominic. She died in 1617. She was a friend of St Martin de Porres, known in his time as 'Martin the Charitable', who cared for slaves in their often wretched conditions, and sought to prevent ill-treatment of animals. As a lay-brother in a Dominican House, he worked as barber, surgeon, wardrobe-keeper and infirmarian! (d. 1639 in Lima). The Church in that continent has suffered for its efforts to encourage a more equitable society where all can live reasonably and in harmony.
