### No room at the Inn?

Two of our local Methodist Ministers have been trying to rally support for the YMCA Drop-In centre on Northampton Road, Kettering for homeless people. They need £6,500 to stop the closure on 23<sup>rd</sup> December and remain open until 10<sup>th</sup> March 2011, by paying staff wages and running costs. Tony and Fiona have been working hard to help secure the future for this very important support-centre for people in distress. They have asked the local churches for help so that the Centre can be retained for the long-term future. There is an opportunity to contribute to this in a second collection this weekend.
