## PASTORAL NOTES

## PENTECOST or WHITSUN ?

Apart from Christmas, the round of Christian feasts have largely disappeared from the national consciousness. Whitmonday Bank Holiday is a memory only now. The Jewish Pentecost feast means fiftieth, and marks that distance in days from the great Passover feast. It was marked by an annual pilgrimage festival to Jerusalem, and celebrated the gift of the Promised Land and, for some rabbis, the gift of the Law on Mount Sinai. It is then a fitting feast to celebrate the new heavenly promise, with the gift of the Holy Spirit, on the infant Church. It has been known as Whitsunday, recalling a time when converts were dressed in the 'white' robes of baptism. We are baptised with water and the Holy Spirit, children of God and members of the Church, 'of every tribe and tongue and people and nation'.
