### PASTORAL NOTES

### MASS INTENTIONS ?

At some early stage of the Mass, the priest may mention an individual intention for a Mass – “the intention for this Mass is specially for the repose of the soul of Mr A...” Often the intention is a remembrance of someone who has died. But it may be for a private intention, or for an anniversary – of a wedding, for example or for an ordination. There are spaces in the First Eucharistic Prayer, the so-called ‘Roman Canon’, for individual names, for the living or for the deceased. Anyone is free to arrange such an ‘intention’ for a particular occasion. Any offering given at such a time for the upkeep of the clergy is entirely free and gratuitous. The November Envelopes, where people list family/friends they wish to remember, may or may not include an offering but all are remembered throughout November at the altar. Where there is an offering, the intention is remembered through the year – but it may be well into the new year, because of the numbers.
