PASTORAL NOTES

UNUSUAL VOCATION

As we hear from the bishop about God's call to each of us, we might remember St Benedict Labre (d. 1783). He tried his vocation with all the most austere Orders in the Church, Trappist, Carthusian, Cistercian – but his nature was not meant for monastic confinement and restrictions. He walked on pilgrimage from his home in France to Rome and begged on the way, discovering his vocation as just being a tramp. He visited the major religious shrines of Europe, always sharing any money given him, meditating, spending days praying in churches, but relying on any food given. On occasion he was beaten by charitable people for giving away the money he received! The last seven years of his life he spent in Rome, being seen everywhere there was Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. He moved into a night shelter in his last days and was taken into a kind man's home for his last night, dying there. He was canonised in 1883. 'The saint is dead' was a refrain round the city in the Holy Week of 1783 when he died. He seems a good saint to remember in our own hard times, when we are also working to eradicate the poverty so many suffer.
