### PASTORAL NOTES

### A NEW RITE ?

We know that the Mass, the Eucharist given to us by Jesus at the Last Supper, has been celebrated around the world in many different languages, and with local particular rituals. Those who have attended a Malayalam Mass for the first time in Kettering will know how different the music, prayers and gestures often are from those familiar to us. Pope Benedict XVI (retired 2012) welcomed into the Catholic Church many former Anglicans who asked to retain many of their cherished rituals, music and forms of prayer, perfectly compatible with our Catholic Faith. Now in England and other English-speaking countries we have priests and people of this particular tradition, known as the Personal Ordinariate of Our Lady of Walsingham. Their services and Mass are now part of our Catholic heritage and anyone is welcome to take part in them. To mark the feast of Our Lady of Walsingham a letter of introduction has been published and is now available at the back of our churches for anyone to study the matter in more detail. You are most welcome to speak to your priests about this. A wider discussion in the parish can always be arranged.
