

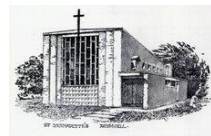

PAPAL VISIT to Coventry on Sunday 19th September

2010 SPECIAL COLLECTION THIS WEEKEND. The State is making a considerable contribution towards the cost of the Papal Visit but the Dioceses are responsible for raising just under half of the total cost. There is to be a second collection in all the Parishes of England, Scotland and Wales this weekend. This Diocese's target is £31000. Please be generous. TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS ETC Bishop Peter's update of 17th May includes:- Dioceses do not receive their allocation of places until mid June, but we do know that access to those events will be by official coaches. The Diocese has been asked to arrange 4 or 5 pick-up places with parking for a large number of cars. At this time it seems our nearest pick up place will be Northampton. **It may be necessary to leave Kettering a little earlier than 5.45am to allow time to transfer in Northampton.**
