### A FAREWELL TO POPE BENEDICT

We are in the rather unique position of knowing the date of a Pope's departure, with a special prayer-card provided by the bishops, and a Mass in Northampton Cathedral celebrated by Bishop Peter. Pope Benedict was elected on 19<sup>th</sup> April 2005, after Easter that year. It seems that he has arranged his resignation in Lent to allow for a possible new election by Easter, a time of new beginnings. His step does seem to make such a move more possible for future Popes, as we expect longer lives for the future. If Pope Benedict has had an eye to the Lent Readings for Mass on 28<sup>th</sup> February, it will be a humble thought – "A blessing on the man who puts his trust in the Lord!", but aware of how difficult it is to see all our motives. The poor man Lazarus is blessed, while the heartless rich man is lost. We, in our need, pray for a fellow Christian who has prayed with us in England, and continues in that bond of prayer.
