**PASTORAL NOTES** **A FORGOTTEN SAINT**

On 27<sup>th</sup> August 1849 an Italian priest, aged 57, died on the platform of Reading Station – quite a modern institution in those days. He had had a heart-attack. The priest's name was Dominic Barberi and he was born of simple farming stock in Italy in 1792. He became a priest of the Congregation of the Passion (Passionists), and, while knowing no English, was convinced he would one day work as a missionary in England.

In 1841 he did indeed reach England and for eight years preached missions and retreats, in his broken English, founding four new Passionist communities, and, especially in the confessional, touching people's lives. He was sent to receive John Henry Newman into the Church in Birmingham: Newman said he recognised his sanctity immediately. It is an improbable story, but suggests we are to find God's saints in unlikely places and people – which includes ourselves!
