PASTORAL NOTES

Since the fall of the so-called 'Iron Curtain', we have become more familiar with the story of Catholics who lived under Communist rule, as in Poland and elsewhere. The history of the Catholic Church in Ukraine looks back to St Josaphat who became a monk of the eastern rite and abbot of Vilna at the time when the Orthodox Christians of the province of Kiev were newly re-united with the Pope, as successor of St Peter. Josaphat devoted his life to maintaining and spreading this union in the face of acute difficulties from Catholics as well as opponents. A good and kind man, worldly ambitions were against him, and he was murdered by a mob in 1623 at his church. Catholics in Ukraine continue today, celebrating Mass in the eastern way, enriching us with their traditions, looking back to a time when East and West were united in one Church.

This week Pope Benedict has announced arrangements for Anglicans to join us, while maintaining many of their rich traditions of prayer and worship. Where people seek admission into the Catholic Church it remains always a matter of conviction and faith. In our present society it remains our continual calling to work with other Christians in mutual respect, prayer and care for those in need.
