**PASTORAL NOTES THE TRINITY, HOLY & SECULAR**  
Last Wednesday the 'Footsteps' group gathered at Rushton Triangular Lodge. You have to be overwhelmed by the number of 'threes' in the building, beginning with the three walls. Sir Thomas Tresham, imprisoned briefly for his faith, imagined the Lodge as a statement of faith (Trinity) and also in honour of his family. The 'Tres' of Tresham means 'three' in Latin, and Sir Thomas's wife apparently used to call him 'Tres'. Over the door are the words 'Tres Testimonium Dant' – 'Three bear witness', which can mean Tresham in his witness for the faith, or the words of St John: "There are three that bear witness, the Spirit, the water and the blood" (1 John 5). Certainly 'blood' would be appropriate for one who suffered for his faith and left a unique memorial to it. The 'threes' do get a bit much: a recently discovered piece of music attributed to Sir Thomas or his family from the 16<sup>th</sup> century includes exactly 33 'Alleluia!'. But the building also includes the enigmatic Latin words 'Non Mihi': 'Not to me', Lord, but to your Name give the glory. The Lodge is well worth a visit.
