PASTORAL NOTES

CHRISTIAN UNITY

We have come to the end of Christian Unity Week, but we have not come to the end of Christ's desire that "all might be one" just as He is one with the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit. The opening document of the Vatican II Council, 'Lumen Gentium', opens with a chapter entitled 'The Mystery of the Church'. Let me quote from it: "The Church, in Christ, is a sacrament – a sign and instrument, that is, of communion with God and of the unity of the entire human race This church, constituted and organised as a society in the present world, subsists in the Catholic Church, which is governed by the successor of Peter and by the bishops in communion with him. Nevertheless, many elements of sanctification and of truth are found outside its visible confines. Since these are gifts belonging to the church of Christ, they are forces impelling towards catholic unity".
