PASTORAL NOTES **ALL SOULS DAY**
Every year on 2nd November we pray for all the faithful departed. When a Jesuit missionary, Matteo Ricci, travelled into China bravely in the 17th century, he discovered their religious worship of their ancestors. But he came to realise this was respect, rather than our notion of worship. Perhaps that can be a help for us, in thinking about prayer for the Holy Souls, where imagination can be a hindrance! It reminds us that we belong to a larger community than the living, and also part of the Church. It is a community, in this life, where we help each other, fellow-sinners, with our prayers, respect and example. "All the ties of friendship and affection" do not disappear with death. We remain united, in love, prayer and good-will. May the communion we have with the heavenly host encourage us in care for one another in this life.
