## PASTORAL NOTES

We welcome members of the Langley family to 10.30am Mass at St Edward's today. On the closest Sunday to the Feast of Our Lady of Walsingham we will be blessing a statue to her, donated in memory of their time as parishioners here (see last week's newsletter). St Edward's Parish has had links for the last century with Walsingham. At the beginning of the 20<sup>th</sup> century the Northamptonshire diocese stretched all the way out to the east coast. Clergy and laity from St Edward's and Northamptonshire diocese were heavily involved in the revival of the Slipper Chapel as a centre of pilgrimage to Our Lady. In 1948, for example, St Edward's was an overnight station for one section of the Cross Carrying Pilgrimage for Peace, Penance and Prayer, in which 400 pilgrims travelled from 14 points across the country to Walsingham. Fr Gerard Langley, who grew up in St Edward's Parish, was in charge of the shrine at this time. Our links continue today as our Holy Trinity Church, Desborough, plays host to pilgrims setting out on Student Cross to Walsingham each Easter.
