PASTORAL NOTES **PRAYERS THIS WEEK**
We pray regularly for the sick in our parish. Please let the priests know of any in need of a visit. Your prayers are also requested for Canon Tim Russ who many years ago was Secretary to Bishop Charles Grant (retired 1982). Canon Tim is now parish priest in Great Missenden parish in South bucks.
Next Saturday is the annual feast of the martyrs of England and Wales, spanning a period of roughly 150 years, from 1535 to 1688. Many ancient houses in our area have 'priest-holes' hiding places from that time, as at Great Harrowden or Rushton Hall or Drayton House near Thrapston, and there are also burial sites of priests serving our area for the small remnant of Catholics in the 18th and 19th centuries: at Kingscliffe churchyard and Deene Park church, on the way to Stamford. One of the surviving legacies of that period has been the close working together of priests and people in our parishes. There are many societies in our parish and helping-groups, always happy for new members.
