**PASTORAL NOTES**                      **OUR PASTORAL AREA OR DEANERY**  
While the Bishop is shepherd for the whole diocese, he also divides the diocese into more manageable groups of parishes known as deaneries, with a Dean to call meetings etc. Our area includes the four parishes of Corby – Our Lady's, St Brendan's, St Patrick's and St John Ogilvie's (a Scottish martyr of the Reformation, in a town where many settled from Scotland in the days of the Steel Works). St Brendan's and St Patrick's have grouped together under one parish priest – so there are three priests in Corby, and two active deacons. Apart from Kettering, our area also includes Oundle Parish and Thrapston/Raunds Parish. These two are also grouped under one (parish) priest. Two retired priests often help there weekly: it is a very large area. There is a deacon in training. We also have our two priests and a deacon in Kettering parish. Every church (and we have four) has two representatives for an area Council – to which the bishop is coming on 1<sup>st</sup> October. If you have any questions you would like raised, have a word with one of the reps. or one of the clergy. The bishop wants to know how we will manage in the future!
