PASTORAL NOTES

HOW MANY NATIONS ?

Throughout the 'Church' Year there are many saints remembered – some very much to do with this country – others suggesting other countries. Each country will tend to have its own saints. In the distant past (or even in the present) local people have 'canonised' some local person seen as outstandingly faithful. Today a whole procedure of canonisation takes place, including strictly authenticated miracles. But Bishop Oscar Romero, shot and killed at Mass in El Salvador, was quickly revered locally for his devotion to the poor and their just care. In our calendar 1st July mentions St Oliver Plunkett who was martyred in 1681, archbishop of Armagh. On 3rd July St Thomas, apostle, will be specially celebrated in the Indian subcontinent as their special apostle, and on Thursday there is mention of St Elisabeth of Portugal, a great peacemaker, who died 1336. In Nettuno, in Italy, south of Rome, the feast of St Maria Goretti, died 1902, has become the focus of campaigns for the protection of the young from exploitation. It is also the feast on Saturday of St Thomas More, patron of Raunds Church, and our own primary school.
