A United Nations office oversees all care for refugees, while Father Jo, with a sprinkling of helpers, offers his pastoral care where so many are Catholics. There is an irony that they are currently suffering great heat and consequent shortage of water, while we seem to have the opposite. On a brighter note. Father Jo writes that young Isaac, hoping for the priesthood, has passed his 'O' level exams and is now signed up for the 'A' level school course without any problem!
