Diocesan Year of Prayer and Vocation This month we are asked to "pray for our Sick and Housebound and those who care for them; and their vocation within the Church". This reminds us that there may be many such people, who we no longer see in Church who need our support, by way of visits from the SVP, Legion of Mary and home Communion. Diocese of Northampton Lay Formation Fund.

This fund is for those living in the diocese who are in active ministry, and who would like to deepen their faith or learning. It can be used for theological courses, such as those run by Maryvale or Newman College, or for more practical learning that will benefit both the person themselves and the parish, such as flower arranging or book-keeping. It covers vocational training, such as Certificates in Chaplaincy. Finally, the fund can be used to offset the costs of local courses such as booking speakers or buying DVDs. Although we were only officially notified of the availability of these funds in mid June the first deadline for applications is 20th July!
