PASTORAL NOTES **Our Patron Saint**
It is unfortunate that the feast of our patron saint, Edward, King and Confessor, has fallen this year on a Saturday (13th October), so has been somewhat forgotten. Our original church is now our church-hall, but items from that 'hall' were eventually stored in the new church – and partly forgotten. Around 2001 work was arranged by the Diocese to alter, among other things, the lighting in church – which entailed exploring inside the false ceiling. This took curious workmen to a room above the altar, to find a number of pieces of coloured glass, but above all the lovely stained-glass window of St Edward, dated back to around 1893, and now displayed on the left-hand side of the sanctuary. It shows him with a dove on his shoulder, the Holy Spirit guiding his kindly rule. He built a great abbey at Westminster which was completed in 1065, just before he died. May he pray for us.

DESBOROUGH
On Monday last we met in the Church with Hugh Davies, the Diocesan Director who is himself a Chartered Surveyor, and David Wilson, the Diocesan Surveyor, regarding the state of the ceiling in Holy Trinity Church. Their advice was that **on Health and Safety grounds** the Church should be closed immediately and that it should be padlocked. Please do not attempt to enter the building unless accompanied by Danny Cannon, the Parish Property Manager. (07900 827411). Arrangements have been made during this last week to move as much as possible in to the hall so that all usual Masses can continue. As reported last week the Trustees of the Miss Quartly Trust did commission an independent surveyor to examine the property, and report back to them. That Surveyor spent several hours on the premises on Friday 5th October and has suggested that her report will be with the Trustees within two weeks. We hope to meet with the Trustees and the Diocesan advisers shortly after that report has been submitted. Our thoughts and prayers are with the members of the Desborough Community and everybody affected by this situation.
