Desborough update.

The Diocesan Architects have prepared plans for three different options regarding the updating and conversion of the hall into a multi-purpose Church building. These options are all being reviewed by the Quantity Surveyor, who visited the site on Wednesday 6th March. He will be consulting with builders and other professionals before reporting further.

The next step will be for the plans to be exhibited at Holy Trinity for a short time prior to an open meeting when the architects will present and explain them, **and take on board any further thoughts from the congregation. Please be assured that all the suggestions made by the congregation during the consultation period have been conveyed to the architects.** From conversations with the various professionals we have gleaned that the three sets of plans could be available within six weeks.

We need to be aware at this time that there is a concern that any extension outside the walls of the existing building are likely to lead to planning consent issues which could delay the start of work by many months.

PASTORAL NOTES

Daily Through Lent

Those who follow 'My Day-by-Day' booklet will perhaps notice that the daily Lenten Readings are the same each year. (The Sunday Readings follow the Gospel of St Luke still). They begin in the first week by picking up basic thoughts for Lent: so, Monday recalls the 10 commandments but also Jesus' call of charity: 'When I was hungry you gave me to eat'. In Lent we hear the call to love of God and neighbour, Tuesday encourages us in prayer ('the Our Father'), while Wednesday is a call to a change of heart, to turn back to God (Lenten penance). Thursday combines a call to persevere in prayer, and 'to treat others as you would like them to treat you', while Friday and Saturday call for love and prayer for enemies and how God gives us a completely fresh start when we turn to him in conversion of heart.
