EASTER PARKING AT ST EDWARD'S

The London Road (swimming pool) Car Park will be Free of Charge from 6pm on Thursday 18th April until after Easter Monday.

Toilet facilities at St Edward's: The disabled and other toilets in the hall can be accessed via the ramp outside the side door to the left of the Altar; for security reasons the access door has to be locked when unsupervised but the key is available from the Sacristy. The single toilet just outside that church door is usually open during services. **Baby Changing Facilities are in the Disabled Toilet in the Hall.**

USE OF St. EDWARD'S HALL - Would all users please ensure that the hall is left as it was found so as not to inconvenience following users. In particular that tables/chairs are put back, debris removed from the floor and lights turned off. Please also check that the building is locked and the heating switch in the cupboard is off, otherwise the heating may come back on in the night (see notice above cupboard). Thank you.
