I am in the Bishop's House, next to the Cathedral in Northampton., a very splendid Mansion, with garden> I'm not sure how old it is but Northampton Diocese was one of the first seven Dioceses of England and Wales, established by Pope Pius IX in 1860 (I've been able to look round the Cathedral and see again one of the stained glass windows which depicts our own patron, St Edward)

I have a further operation on 11<sup>th</sup> July, and pray that all will be more settled from then on. With my prayers and best wishes, Canon John."
