Food Banks. While we mainly support the "Churches Together Foodbank, and any donations received at St Edwards will continue to go there, we have received the following unhappy news from "The Trussell Trust Food Bank" run by KCU was broken into last weekend. This is the third break in over the past 2 months. Each time there is a break in the level of damage and destruction gets worse.

This time of the year is a very busy time for the food bank due to the school holidays as there is always an increased demand for food parcels. Food stocks are low and the break ins have put an additional strain on the services provided by the Foodbank volunteers.

Donation points in Kettering Borough include Tesco, Sainsbury, Asda and Morrison's; in Burton Latimer at the Library, Sainsbury and the Parish Church and in Desborough at the Co-op and Holy Trinity. The most needed items are: tinned fruit, vegetables, tomatoes, rice pudding, custard, fish; long life milk; pasta sauce; squash/long life juice and biscuits.

Pastoral Notes News From Fr Jo....

"To address the peculiar challenges faced by older persons in refugee settlements, development partners want Government to integrate protection into the older person policy of 2009.

Poor shelter, sanitation, queuing for food rations and diseases are some of the challenges faced by the elderly in refugee settlements.

The latest data by United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), shows that Uganda has 1,276,208 refugees, mostly from South Sudan and the Democratic Republic of Congo (RDC)....A recent protection study by Help Age International and Uganda Reach the Aged Association (URAA) on older South Sudanese refugees in Adjumani revealed that 6 in 10 older people live in fear of safety and that access to services was not only inadequate, but was also not age-friendly....

This year's World Refugee Day was themed, "Step with Refugees – Take a step on World Refugee Day." The UN urged the global community to show that the global public stood with the Refugees. (Fr. Jo's contract to enable him to implement his program interventions – in areas of spiritual welfare, food security and soft skills development, for example, has been extended by Government for another three years.)"
