Dear brothers and sisters in Jesus Christ,
As you know, a few months ago, Bishop Peter has appointed me as priest in charge of St. Edward's Parish in Kettering. I am very grateful to the Bishop for this decision and for his trust in me. It is a great privilege for me and an undeserved honour.
I am 37 years old, I was born in central Poland in Płock Diocese and I have been a priest for twelve years. As a Polish priest I am still getting to know Northampton Diocese where I have lived for seven years. First, for five years I had the privilege of being a parish priest in the Polish parish in Northampton, then as an assistant priest in the parish of Our Lady of Walsingham in Corby. This time your Parish is becoming my new home, a place of prayer, rest and work. I will try to continue the good work and ministry of Canon John, who was a good shepherd to you for twenty-five years. I trust that - with God's help and with your support - I will be able to perform the tasks and duties entrusted to me as best I can.

Fr. Jose-Marie Kizito - Many of you will have seen our house guest Fr Jo who, despite being here to have a complete rest from his arduous work in the Kingwali Refugee Settlement in Uganda, has voluntarily helped out by saying many Masses in the Parish. Here are some statistics about the settlement. Over a period of 18 years (up to 2019) there were 6,844 baptisms, and 2,216 First Holy Communions. Whole families may arrive at the Settlement. Nevertheless, there have been 83 Marriages presided over by the Chaplain! There are inevitably many schools for the children - 14 to be precise (13 Primary and one Senior Secondary). St Patrick's offers scholarships to refugee children at the same time as providing small-scale farming tools to promote food security. Also household items with the approval of UN operatives. There are 30 named UN and international support groups involved with the Settlement. The list could go on, monitoring the spiritual welfare of refugees re-settled abroad. Here is the Mission Statement; - "To nurture and train the refugees and the host nationals around the settlement in the LOVE OF GOD. And to heal them from the begging syndrome to self-development and sustenance through self-help income generator projects. That we may live together". On 21st March 2018 Father Jo welcomed and addressed the Papal Nuncio. The above is a tiny indication of what is at stake
