## THINKING OF GETTING MARRIED IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH?

Congratulations, but have you booked your required marriage preparation course yet? Sadly, in England currently 42% of all marriages end in divorce. However, studies show that couples who do good quality marriage preparation have a much lower rate of divorce and better relationship resilience. Our course at St. Edwards enables you to fully explore and understand what makes your relationship unique and teaches skills for realistic consolidation of your commitment to each other. Many couples on our courses are already living together and may initially feel that attendance is a waste of their time but soon discover new and practical ways to further develop and enrich their relationship. Couples are surprised to learn that divorce statistics for those who have co-habited are much higher but the course explains how to avoid this so it is equally useful to co-habiting couples and those living separately. All relationships benefit from being constructively reflected upon and feedback shows that, no matter how long they have known each other, couples discover skills enabling them to talk and reflect in ways they never imagined! This is important to do before making a full sacramental commitment - so church law requires all couples to attend marriage preparation, whatever their living status or faith. ## Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> February and Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February are the first Friday and Saturday of the month.

Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> February we will have our 5 first Saturday devotions. Beginning at 9.00am with Exposition followed by the Fatima prayers, Rosary and fifteen minutes of meditation. To fulfil this obligation, one must go to confession within eight days of the first Saturday and receive Holy Communion worthily on the day. Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February is the first Friday of the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We begin with exposition at 6.45pm followed by the Litany to the Sacred Heart, The Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary and the Divine Mercy Chaplet. We also include this day, as we do each Friday, the Prayers of The Divine Mercy Apostolate for the sick, dying and deceased. Please support these two important days each month. These are days of Reparation to The Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary for outrages committed against them requested by Jesus Himself.
