## The Rededication of England as The Dowry of Mary

The following is the timeline for rededication:

### Friday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2020

All Catholics will be invited to begin a personal 33-day consecration to Jesus through Mary. This will include an invitation to go to the Sacrament of Confession during Lent.

### Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> March 2020, Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord.

All who are following the consecration will consecrate themselves to Jesus through Mary on this day.

### Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> to Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2020

A three-day triduum of Prayer in which all will be invited to recite the Litany of Saints and Martyrs of England, to pray the Rosary and go to Confession in preparation for the Redirection.

### Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2020

The personal rededication of England as the Dowry of Mary. This will happen in Walsingham, in every Catholic Cathedral, in every parish and in as many homes as possible. In addition to the events outlined above, we are encouraged to prepare spiritually for the rededication by praying the Angelus. This is a communal opportunity for Catholics and all people of good will to place their total trust in Jesus through Mary and to renew their own 'Fiat', 'Yes' to God. Everyone is invited to participate from wherever they are. Like Our Lady, let us say with faith: 'I am the servant of the Lord, be it done to me according to Thy word' (Lk 1:38). I hope that our parish may be spiritually prepared for the rededication of England as the 'Dowry of Mary' on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2020.
