PASTORAL NOTES

TO THE NATIONS

One of the very uplifting elements of our recent Divine Mercy Mass was the presence together of so many different voices. We had our hymns in English, but prayers and Readings mostly repeated in both English and Polish for the first time - also very moving Polish hymns and Malayalee singing, not needing translation in that situation. Many groups came together. The first Reading at Mass throughout the Easter season, Sundays and weekdays, is no longer from the Old Testament (as normally) but entirely from the Acts of the Apostles, giving us a sketch of the spread of the Gospel from Jerusalem to Rome, that is to all the nations. In some traditions, a Deacon will chant through the whole of the Acts of the Apostles on his own in church as a preparation for the Easter Vigil. This does not appeal to all deacons, but is a fine tradition.

CAFOD EASTER DONATIONS

Many thanks for the individual donations totaling £394.88 received over the Easter period, these have been forwarded to CAFOD. Payments can be made at any time, using CAFOD envelopes (available at back of all Churches), whether Gift Aided or not and put into the first collection at any weekend Mass.

Any payments made to CAFOD by 17th May can qualify for the 100% Government Subsidy.

Why Use Offertory Envelopes?

Please remember, there is NO Commitment to pay any particular amount each week, you can still pay what you wish, when you wish, and miss a week if desired.

There are several reasons why the use of offertory envelopes are a good idea:-

1. Being dated, you can be sure not to miss a week accidentally, but you are not committed to pay for weeks when it is not convenient.

2. You will not embarrass your neighbour who might not be able to be as generous as you.

3. You can put any amount, in any week, into the collection. If you pay under Gift Aid amounts are totalled throughout the year and the appropriate tax claim is made on behalf of the Parish automatically. If you are paying sufficient UK Income or Capital Gains tax the parish, being a charity, can claim back the tax that you paid on that money. That could increase your gift by 25%! (If you do wish to take advantage of the Gift Aid scheme, please contact Ken Anderton 01536 514302.
