Picture by the Reading-Stand - Blessed Cyprian Michael Iwene Tansi, born in Nigeria September 1903, baptised aged 9, headmaster aged 21, ordained priest 1937, accepted call to share in contemplative life of Cistercian monks at Mount St Bernard's Abbey, Leicestershire 1950, died 1964 21st January in Leicester General Hospital. 1965 - first steps to establish monastic life in Nigeria. March 1998 - pronounced Blessed by Pope John Paul II in Nigeria. Pray for us.
